Rising 3rd Grade Summer Assignments

### **<u>Reading Summer Assignment</u>** - Due Friday, August 15th, 2025

- 1. Daily Reading
  - a. To best prepare for third grade, I encourage your child to spend time reading every day throughout the summer.
  - b. I've included a reading log to help you keep track of your student's time spent reading this summer.
  - c. I will collect the reading logs when we return to school.
- 2. Book Project
  - a. In addition to daily reading, your child must also choose one book from the included list (from the Gospel Coalition's Suggested Summer Reading) to read in its entirety and then create a related project for that book.
  - b. After your child has completely finished reading the book, your child must choose **one** of the following projects to complete:

### **Project Choices:**

### **Option One - Create a Character Sketch Poster**

Your poster should focus on three main characters from the story. Include the following:

- 1. a large, detailed drawing of three main characters
- 2. several words or phrases, next to each drawing, that describe that character's personality traits, age, appearance, and beliefs

#### \*Your poster will be graded on the accuracy of the information, how well you understand the characters, and neatness.

### **Option Two - Pretend You're a Teacher**

Write your own test to go along with the book. Your test should include 10–15 questions. You also need to include an answer key on a separate sheet of paper. Your questions can be any of the following:

- Multiple choice
- Fill-in-the-blank
- Short answer

Make sure your questions are about the main ideas in the story, not just small details. The questions shouldn't be designed to trick anyone.

\*You will be graded on how well you understand the story, the quality of your questions, neatness, and accuracy on the answer sheet.

### **Option Three - Create a Board Game**

Create a board game based on events and characters from the book. Your game must include the following:

- 1. a game board
- 2. any game pieces needed to play the game
- 3. a rule sheet with clear directions on how to play the game
- 4. references to characters and events from the story

\*You will be graded on creativity, neatness, and effort.

### Math Summer Assignment - Due Friday, August 15th, 2025

The summer assignment for math will require the use of the online learning platform, IXL. Returning CCS students will already have a username and password that they can use to login. If your student is new to CCS, or if your student does not know their previous login information, please contact the front office for assistance.

- Complete the 20 math lessons on IXL that are listed in the attachment, "IXL Summer Boost Skill Plan".
- The plan includes one lesson per day, for 20 days. However, 20 days is just a guideline. Your student can complete as many lessons as they choose on any given day.
- To access each lesson (via the online website or the IXL app), type in the "3-character skill code" for each IXL skill in the search bar.
- Students should work on each IXL skill until a SmartScore of at least an 80 is achieved.
- The SmartScore will be automatically recorded and saved within IXL, so you do not need to turn anything in, physically, upon completion.
- However, I have included a chart on the next page if you would like to use it as a resource to help you keep track of your student's progress.
